Last year, response to our Holiday Fundraiser allowed us to complete Home Preservation projects for 30 families who were unable to undertake this necessary work on their own. We replaced roofs, windows, floors, appliances, and we built ramps for ease of access. One of those families we partnered with were Theresa and Curtis Loving from Tobyhanna, Pennsylvania. This local couple came to Habitat as they were both disabled and needed assistance with repairs to their roof. They found Habitat to be an answer to their prayers for help, and now the Loving home is a safe and secure haven.
